## **FOXBORO CAMPUS – FOXBORO SPORTS CENTER SAFETY PROTOCOLS AND FACILITY OPERATIONS FOR THE SKATING ACADEMY**

### **Introduction**

These new procedures are intended to offer an increased level of safety, and are based on all currently available information from the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, and the new operating guidelines from U.S. Figure Skating and the U.S. Ice Rinks Association.

Please read all the ensuing information. Everyone using the facility will be expected to know these procedures, and to follow them.

### **General Practices**

- The rink has been sanitized and cleaned and is following all safety protocols mandated by the State guidelines using hospital grade electrostatic sprayer and continues to sanitize throughout the day. Foxboro Sport Center will provide several hand sanitizer stations around the facility and can be found on the walls.
- If you feel sick, stay home. Please do not come to class if you suspect or are experiencing any of the published COVID-19 symptoms associated with infection.
- A mask/face covering must be worn upon entering the facility and remain on at all times.
- Only one skater, and one parent or guardian will be allowed in the Foxboro Sport Center. The Skating Club of Boston Skating Academy will require all persons entering Rink 2 to submit a Health Questionnaire and Waiver prior to arrival using the online form or on paper at time of check-in and a temperature check.
- Skaters are asked to arrive no more than 15 minutes before their scheduled lesson.
- All parents and skaters must follow the 6' social distancing requirement.
- All parents and skater must enter thru the front of the facility.
- All parents and skaters must exit the building once classes have been completed thru the door in front of the SCOB office, NO LOITERING.

### **Skater Information**

- Must be a returning Skating Academy skater
- Skaters who are eligible – Age 7 and up (including Adults, if applicable), must be working on Basic 3 – Basic 6 and/or Pre Free Skate – Free Skate 6 or Hockey 3 - 4. Previous Basic/Hockey 1

and 2 Skating Academy skaters who are interested in skating will be placed on a waitlist and will be notified of availability.

- Skaters must have their own skates as rentals will not be available.
- Skaters must come dressed but are allowed to put skates on in the facility.
- Due to safety regulations our Summer classes will be held for 40 minutes without practice ice. Cost will remain the same but classes will be smaller (4 to 5 skaters per coach). This will allow more attention to skaters for the entire 40-minute scheduled lesson.
- Upon check-in, we will have a master list of skaters registered for the session. At the first lesson, each registered skater will be handed a skater name tag/stickers and will be instructed where to go on the ice.
- A rink map will be emailed with the Welcome Letter prior to the first class for where to go for their class location once in the rink.
- Each coach will be assigned a location on the ice, 12 feet apart from each other. The ice will be marked to keep each skater at a safe distance.
- Once lesson is complete, skater must leave facility within 15 minutes. For a single flow of traffic and to minimize crowding, all skaters must exit through the exit thru the door in front of the SCOB office.
- Parent must provide Skating Academy with a valid phone number upon registration in case of an emergency.
